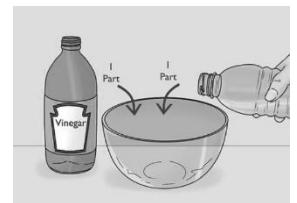

ECO TIPS: Tackle Limescale with Vinegar

A great alternative to harsh chemical descalers, distilled white vinegar works wonders on limescale.

For shinier, limescale-free taps, soak a cloth in a solution of equal parts distilled white vinegar and water. Wrap it around the



tap and leave overnight then in the morning remove the cloth, rinse and dry the tap. To unclog a limescale-crusting shower head, unscrew it and soak it in a solution of equal parts white vinegar and water to banish limescale. Never use vinegar on gold taps, though. (Source: Good Housekeeping)
