

Evensong Service 7 April 6pm St Peter's

On behalf of The Prayer Book Society, I am arranging an Evensong Service, to be held at St. Peter's Church, Lodsworth on 7th April 2024, at 6pm. The service will be held according to the rite of the Book of Common Prayer.

The Book of Common Prayer, or Prayer Book, was the first official comprehensive liturgical compendium put together by the newly reformed Anglican Church. In other words, bringing together daily services (Offices) with the appointed Old and New Testament readings, psalms and prayers for each day. The most well-known edition is from 1662 and remains in use to this day as the official text of the Anglican Church.

The use of the Prayer Book declined from the middle of the last century and was largely superseded by the Alternative Service Book, and more recently by Common Worship. However, the Prayer Book has enjoyed something of a revival in recent years with people discovering or rediscovering the poetic old language cuts through to the rough and tumble of 21st century life in a way that modern, softer and more euphemistic language does not.
